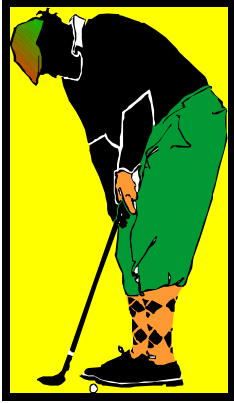

In November 2009 when AGO plays at the new revised course at Deltona Hills C. C. we will be playing a Two Man, Best Ball format. Please be advised that when you send in your entry that you also send in the name of your partner for this two man, best ball event. **NOTE:** The difference between handicaps of each player should not exceed 12 strokes i.e. If you are an 8 handicap, the handicap of your partner should not exceed 20.

**New AGO members who have not played 3 times with AGO, and do not have an AGO handicap, can still participate, and will be assigned a handicap for the 2 MAN BEST BALL format.**

There will be **TWO Flights** that will cover the total number of players in the field dependent on the **TOTAL HANDICAP** of the two players. Your AGO board will assign teams to one of the two flights based on the **TOTAL HANDICAP** rule.

For scoring purposes all scorecards will be dotted with appropriate strokes assigned for each player and for each hole. **NOTE: EACH HOLE WILL REQUIRE FOUR (4) SCORES.** 1) The **GROSS SCORE** of Player A., 2) The **GROSS SCORE** of Player B., 3) The **BEST GROSS** score of one of the two players and 4) The **BEST NET SCORE** (using the handicap strokes assigned to that hole) of one of the two players.

After completing 18 holes your card should show: 1) The total **GROSS SCORE** for player A. 2) The total **GROSS SCORE** for player B. 3) The total **GROSS BEST BALL SCORE** for the team and 4) The total **NET BEST BALL SCORE** for the team.

As in the past, the lowest **TOTAL Gross Score** for a team out of **ALL** the teams entered shall be declared **GROSS SCORE BEST BALL CHAMPIONS** while the lowest **TOTAL Net Score** for a team out of **ALL** the teams entered shall be declared **NET SCORE BEST BALL CHAMPIONS**. Finally, the remainder of winning scores shall be based on a lowest **NET SCORE** in each flight.

**SUMMARY:** Prizes will be awarded to the two players in the **GROSS SCORE CHAMPION** category; the two players in the **NET SCORE CHAMPION** category. Approximately five prizes will be awarded on a **NET SCORE** basis to each player of each team in Flights 1 and Flight 2.

**NOTE:** Since a player might be requested as a partner by more than one other player be sure and sign up early to clear up any confusion as to **WHO** the two players are that compose a team. .

#### **Rule of the Month**

#### ***28/4 Ball Deemed Unplayable Through the Green Dropped in Hazard***

**Q. A player's ball lies through the green. The player deems the ball unplayable. In proceeding under Rule 28b or c, the player drops a ball in a hazard. Is this permissible?**

**A. Yes.**

**Ball Deemed Unplayable in Water Hazard Is Dropped in Hazard and Played — See 20-7/2.**

**Ball Deemed Unplayable Dropped in Ground Under Repair from Which Play Prohibited; Ball Then Dropped Under Ground Under Repair Rule — See 25-1b/14.5.**
