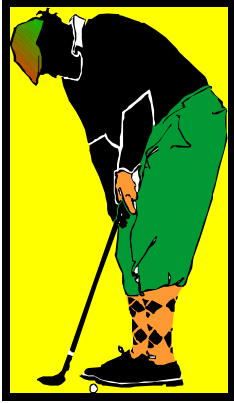

By the comments I heard after play at The Deltona Club, I'm sure AGO will be playing there again next year. This old course had a major facelift and the results were very enjoyable. We felt the course more than made up for the small clubhouse. The course was very user friendly which helped produce some good results.

The Two Man Best Ball format is a lot of work but it was well received. We wanted to provide another way to compete from our normal individual play. We had some good scores to report with the Wilson/Rice team taking overall low gross (66) and the G. Miller/McCann team having the best low net (57). We had the winners of flight A, Burt/Russell turn-in a net 61 and flight B, Behe/Oakley with a 57. We actually had a tie in both flights with Ingram/Newton in flight A and Gracequi/R. Miller in flight B getting second place. Matching low net scores, starting from the # 1 handicap hole, broke the ties. Usually most of these flight winners' names can be found on the closet to the pin results too but not this time, congratulations to Frey, Adamson, Stocksett and Noon for at least playing one hole out of 18 well.

I'd like to thank our membership, for bring in a good number of new members in the last several months. Talking up the fun we have being a member helps our organization in many ways. As in any organization or club, members come and go. We lose some members so we need to replace them. The more players we have given us negotiating leverage when signing up courses. We had 74 players at The Deltona Club, which has been the norm. Looking back over this past year, out of the 12 months, we were in the 70 -79 player range 9 times. Two months in the low 80's and this past August we had 90 players when we played at Reunion. If we can all remember to talk up AGO to our friends, co-workers, church acquaintances, other clubs, chamber of commerce's, etc. that will help keep us stable and hopefully growing. We're limited to the advertising we can afford, so word of mouth is our best source. Under these hard times our low \$39 membership fee is surprisingly affordable. Our next tournament is Dec. 13th. We'll be playing over in the Daytona area at Indigo Lakes. I can't remember ever playing there with our AGO group, lets hope for warm weather. The course is easy to find and I have driven there from Maitland/I-4 to the course in just 50 minutes. Its right off I-95, just one exit past where I-4 hits I-95.

Also as a reminder, in order to qualify for our upcoming Champions in May, you must have played in at least three AGO tournaments within the past 11 months (June 09 - April 2010). The championships will be held in May on a Saturday / Sunday. The exact dates and locations will be announced soon.

Rule of the Month

25-2. Embedded Ball

A ball embedded in its own pitch-mark in the ground in any closely mown area through the green may be lifted, cleaned and dropped, without penalty, as near as possible to the spot where it lay but not nearer the hole. The ball when dropped must first strike a part of the course through the green. "Closely mown area" means any area of the course, including paths through the rough, cut to fairway height or less.

Through the Green

"*Through the green*" is the whole area of the course except:

- a. The teeing ground and putting green of the hole being played; and
 - b. All hazards on the course.
