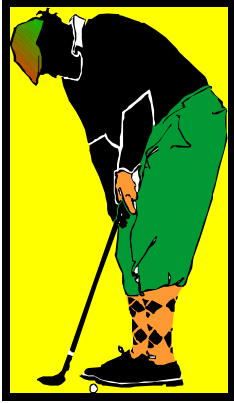

FROM THE PRESIDENT'S DESK

One of the few good things caused by the sluggish economy.

Next Month we'll be playing at a course that's new to AGO, Sugar Loaf Mountain. It was built and opened as another private course just a few years ago but because of hard times they to are welcoming our group. So come out and play, you may never have this opportunity again. Be sure to follow the driving directions shown in this newsletter. If you ask Map Quest you may get lost.

Since we have some new members, I'd like to mention an AGO pairings policy. When sending in your entry you always have the option of requesting to play with another member or guest. Most of the time we will honor your request but sometimes we can't. For example, we've had three players request to play with the same golfer. That same popular golfer then requests to play with someone else. Or the person you request doesn't enter or his entry is late. These scenarios make pairings difficult. So please understand if you're not paired with whom you asked for there's probably a good reason behind it. This rule of only two players playing together instead of four has come about more because of score keeping. If your playing with two players that you usually don't play with, the scoring becomes more accurate than playing in a foursome with four buddies. Now in certain cases if you want to play with a foursome because they're guests or for some other special reason, we'll try to make that foursome pairings. Just let us know. But our rule is you can only request one other person to play with. This is also a good way of meeting new friends and finding other golfers you may want to play with outside of AGO.

We try to get the pairings posted to our website by late Friday. We usually do but sometimes it doesn't happen. If you have sent in your entry and don't see your name don't let that stop you from playing. Either contact me (see www.agogolf.net) or just show up at the tournament.

**Rule of the Month
Rule 28. Ball Unplayable**

The player may deem his ball unplayable at any place on the *course*, except when the ball is in a *water hazard*. The player is the sole judge as to whether his ball is unplayable. If the player deems his ball to be unplayable, he must, under penalty of one stroke: a. Play a ball as nearly as possible at the spot from which the original ball was last played (see Rule 20-5); or b. Drop a ball behind the point where the ball lay, keeping that point directly between the *hole* and the spot on which the ball is dropped, with no limit to how far behind that point the ball may be dropped; or c. Drop a ball within two club-lengths of the spot where the ball lay, but not nearer the *hole*. If the unplayable ball is in a *bunker*, the player may proceed under Clause a, b or c. If he elects to proceed under Clause b or c, a ball must be dropped in the *bunker*. When proceeding under this Rule, the player may lift and clean his ball or *substitute* a ball. Penalty for Breach of Rule:
Match play - Loss of hole; Stroke play - Two strokes.
