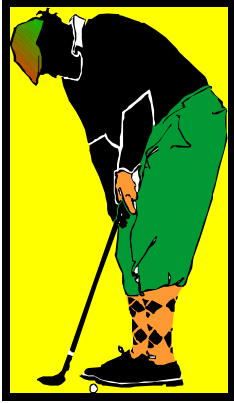

We still had players finishing almost two hours after the first players were done with their rounds. We have a rule on the books that a player will be disqualified if he doesn't complete his round and turn in his scorecard in a maximum of 5 hours & 5 minutes. Speed of play and playing ready golf are part of the rules. So starting at Rio Pinar, we will take down the scoring sheets and basically stop scoring after 5 hours and 15 minutes.

If a group in front of you is playing to slow, you should let them know that they need to pick it up. If the group in front of you gets so ahead of you that you can't see them anymore, then you know to speed it up. Always be ready to make your shot and keep track when you teed off and how long you've been playing. Write that time down and keep it in mind.

Sept. 20th we'll be playing at Rio Pinar, tee time at 8:00 am. Rio's another private course that is an old Orlando favorite. It used to be home to the PGA, Citrus Open. This was the pro stop before Arnie built Bay Hill. It's long and always in good shape. Remember to send in your entry forms ASAP. Hope to see you all there and thank you for your continued support.

Rule of the Month

24-1. Movable Obstruction

A player may take relief, without penalty, from a movable *obstruction* as follows:

- a. If the ball does not lie in or on the *obstruction*, the *obstruction* may be removed. If the ball *moves*, it must be replaced, and there is no penalty, provided that the movement of the ball is directly attributable to the removal of the *obstruction*. Otherwise, Rule 18-2a applies.**
- b. If the ball lies in or on the *obstruction*, the ball may be lifted and the *obstruction* removed. The ball must *through the green* or in a *hazard* be dropped, or on the *putting green* be placed, as near as possible to the spot directly under the place where the ball lay in or on the *obstruction*, but not nearer the *hole*.**

The ball may be cleaned when lifted under this Rule.

When a ball is in motion, an *obstruction* that might influence the movement of the ball, other than *equipment* of any player or the *flagstick* when attended, removed or held up, must not be moved. (Exerting influence on ball - see Rule 1-2.)

Note: If a ball to be dropped or placed under this Rule is not immediately recoverable, another ball may be *substituted*.

In AGO, we require three scores in AGO events before a new or returning member can win handicap based prizes. This system "protects the field" against those dreaded sandbaggers. Once you have three scores, the handicap computer program will use the lowest 2 of 3 scores, and you will be eligible for handicapped based prizes. As you play through the year, we take 2 of 4, 3 of 6, etc. until ultimately your handicap (as is everyone's) is computed on the best 5 of the last 10 scores. AGO handicaps are not official USGA handicaps, because we only count scores recorded in our tournaments. For an official USGA handicap, you must count all scores every time you play. We don't do that.
