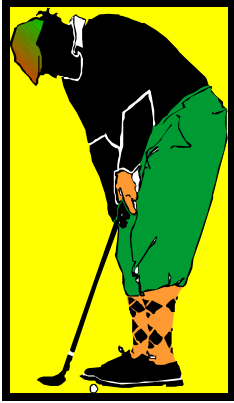

Since we have so many new AGO members the board thought it'd be a good idea to show a checklist of what should be done at each tournament (besides play golf): First, send in your entry as early as you can. You don't have to wait for the newsletter. We give you an entry form on the rules sheets we distribute the morning of all our tournaments.

When you arrive at the course, please check in right away. Get your scorecard and sign up for all the games you like to play. Then locate your cart, put your clubs on the back and then go and warm up, visit with others, etc.

Right before we tee off we'll make some announcements. Please gather around and pay attention and listen to any final instructions.

After completing play, add up the score and deduct their handicap to determine the final net score. MAKE SURE YOU AND THE PLAYER WHO'S SCORE YOU'VE BEEN KEEPING HAS SIGNED THE CARD. WE NEED TWO SIGNATURES, IF NOT YOU COULD BE DISQUALIFIED.

Then turn those cards in immediately. Do these before you do anything else. Also remember to report your scores for either of the skins games. Once the scores have been handed in you can then go to your car, go to the bar, but remember, to get those scorecards handed in first.

These procedures really help us out. The people keeping these scores would like to finish as early as possible so they to can enjoy time with other members discussing how great a day they had or how the golf gods screwed them.

February 15th we'll be playing at Twin Rivers GC in Oviedo. With so many of the holes being elevated and well bunkered, makes this course always a challenge. Hope to see you all there. Thanks for your support and keep inviting those guests.

20-1. Lifting and Marking

A ball to be lifted under the [Rules](#) may be lifted by the player, his [partner](#) or another person authorized by the player. In any such case, the player is responsible for any breach of the [Rules](#).

The position of the ball must be marked before it is lifted under a [Rule](#) that requires it to be replaced. If it is not marked, **the player incurs a penalty of one stroke** and the ball must be replaced. If it is not replaced, **the player incurs the general penalty for breach of this Rule**, but there is no additional penalty under Rule [20-1](#).

If a ball or ball-marker is accidentally [moved](#) in the process of lifting the ball under a [Rule](#) or marking its position, the ball or ball-marker must be replaced. There is no penalty, provided the movement of the ball or ball-marker is directly attributable to the specific act of marking the position of or lifting the ball. Otherwise, **the player incurs a penalty of one stroke under this Rule or Rule [18-2a](#)**.

Exception: If a player incurs a penalty for failing to act in accordance with Rule [5-3](#) or [12-2](#), there is no additional penalty under Rule [20-1](#).

Note: The position of a ball to be lifted should be marked by placing a ball-marker, a small coin or other similar object immediately behind the ball. If the ball-marker interferes with the play, [stance](#) or [stroke](#) of another player, it should be placed one or more clubhead-lengths to one side.

Slow play is no fun. Play ready golf. Do the little things to keep it moving. Thanks!
