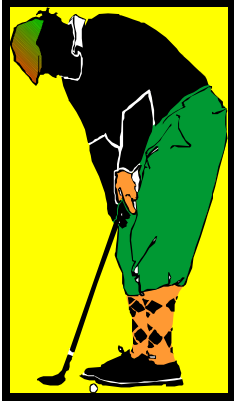

FROM THE PRESIDENT'S DESK

I was surprise there weren't more red numbers but the board got positive feedback so we may return sometime soon. It's a nice course with good facilities and the staff really showed that they were glad we were there.

Our winners thought the course was really nice; our low gross & net were Tim Wilson (73) and Al Chandler (66). Tim Wilson has a 1 handicap so I guess we aren't surprised with his score but Al who is an 11 handicap broke 80 with a real nice 77. I don't know if that was a career low but it was a great score for someone who usually scores in the 80's. The flight A winner was one of your board members, John Atkinson (69), Flight B was Carl Russell (67) and Flight C winner was Wen Stocksett (66). John proved the old golf expression "drive for show & putt for dough" is a correct one. He had only 27 putts that helped him score so well.

I'd also like to do a little promoting on the value of playing in our "gross skins" games. At Indigo Lakes there were 3 gross skins that paid \$100 to three players. Those three players that won the \$100 each didn't even place in their flights. Which shows it's a game not just for the low handicappers. Net skins is a good cash game as well and it can have very attractive payouts. If you haven't played in either game for a while it maybe time to try one or both of them. For you new members who haven't established a handicap yet, you can play in the gross skins game only.

A reminder for those who play both games and for everyone else, it's your responsibility to record all scores, correctly do the final math calculations, along with signing your cards. Your AGO staff shouldn't have a help fill out and complete scorecards. If they're not completed correctly when they're handed in, they will not be used in the scoring. So take the time to fill them out completely.

One other point the board wants to stress, when entering a tournament, whether it's through the regular mail or via email, if we receive either after the Wednesday before the event we cannot guarantee you'll be able to play with your requested partner. So get your entry with check in to us as early as possible. We had 12 members who told us they were coming to Indigo Lakes after the pairings were completed. This created a lot of extra work and confusion. We always try to accommodate a few last minute entrees that had reasonable excuses but don't expect any favors just because you "forgot" to get your entry in on time.

Next month we'll be playing at Deer Island. Yes, it is on an island in Lake Dora. This is one of the more attractive and challenging courses in the area. For those who have never played there, you need to experience this course, for it's truly one of a kind. We'll be playing there on January 17th at 8:00 AM so get those entries in the mail.

Thanks again for all your support and we'll look forward in a good turnout to start the New Year off right.

Rule of the Month

24-2a/1 Mental Interference by Obstruction

Q. A player's ball lies several inches to the side of a sprinkler head. The sprinkler head does not physically interfere with the player's stance or the area of his intended swing. However, the sprinkler head bothers the player mentally. Is the player entitled to relief under Rule 24-2b?

A. No. See Rule 24-2a.

24-2. Immovable Obstruction

a. Interference

Interference by an immovable obstruction occurs when a ball lies in or on the obstruction, or when the obstruction interferes with the player's stance or the area of his intended swing. If the player's ball lies on the putting green, interference also occurs if an immovable obstruction on the putting green intervenes on his line of putt. Otherwise, intervention on the line of play is not, of itself, interference under this Rule.
