FROM THE PRESIDENT'S DESK – BY LARRY PRILL, PRESIDENT AGO

The biggest news that came out of Sanctuary Ridge was the great turnout, 103 players challenged this hilly course and braved the rain that we were supposed to have later in the day. It was good to be able to fill four flights instead of the normal three. All these players added more opportunities to win prize certificates and cash. Even our 50-50 game paid a nice \$92.00. Though we did have some rainy weather we still had some wonderful scores.

Jerry Fusco shot a gross 72 which was a great score considering the bad weather. To shoot par on a tough course with all that rain and wind was amazing. Our low net winner was Tim Smith who shot 85, which netted down to 61. Our handicap chair John Atkinson will make sure your handicap is adjusted. Nice shooting. The winners of each flight were Russ Judge Flight A, Perry Hochstetler Flight B, Rick Harris Flight C and Steve Claxton Flight D.

At our last board meeting we discussed a reoccurring problem that needs to be addressed, bringing your entry money the day of the tournament. If you email or call anytime prior to that event, please mail in your check instead of bringing it to the course on Sunday. Even if it's the day before, please send it to the AGO P.O. Box 140181, Orlando, FL. 32814. We had 27 late entries last month and it was hard enough to find a place in the pairings for all of them, plus keeping track of their payments. So put them in the mail. If you still want to pay at the course, that will cost you an extra \$5.00 LATE FEE. If over 80% of our members can send in their entries in a timely fashion, why can't the other 20%? We try to accommodate a few players that have last minute changes in their schedules, but 27 late entries is taking advantage of our kindness. We have looked into offering payments via credit cards, but it's an expense we would have to pass on to everyone. Plus we never have people asking for this service. If it would be more convenient, then please let me know. If we have enough interest it may be worth providing. So if you want to let us know you're playing via email or phone that's fine, but please send in your check before that Sunday.

For many of our newer players, please complete your scorecards. Have them added up, showing your final net score. Be sure to have two signatures on the card (yours and whoever kept the score) and hand them in immediately after your round. Drop it off first, and then go to your car. And for all of you that play the net and gross skins, be sure that scorecard is accurately completed, with your full name, etc. We get cards with only the first name, and not tallied correctly. If the cards aren't completed properly we can't honor your score.

I also wanted to mention that we do not use the triple bogey rule anymore. We instead have a maximum of eight strokes per hole. Once you reach eight just pickup your ball and move on. I know we had a mistake on the last rule sheet, it showed we were using the triple bogey rule. Know that we will only use the 8 stroke max on any hole, no more triple bogey.

It's on to Remington Golf Club this month (April 18th) at 8:00 am. They have offered a nice package, which includes golf, cart, range balls, tax, all prizes plus hot dog and soda at the turn and lunch after your round for \$45.00 It's a great course so check your schedule now and plan on attending (it's \$45 whether you eat lunch or not).

24-3. Ball in Obstruction Not Found

It is a question of fact whether a ball that has not been found after having been struck toward an obstruction is in the obstruction. In order to apply this Rule, it must be known or virtually certain that the ball is in the obstruction. In the absence of such knowledge or certainty, the player must proceed under Rule 27-1.

b. Ball in Immovable Obstruction Not Found

If it is known or virtually certain that a ball that has not been found is in an immovable *obstruction*, the player may take relief under this Rule. If he elects to do so, the spot where the ball last crossed the outermost limits of the *obstruction* must be determined and, for the purpose of applying this Rule, the ball is deemed to lie at this spot and the player must proceed as follows:

(ii) In a Bunker: If the ball last crossed the outermost limits of the immovable *obstruction* at a spot in a *bunker*, the player may *substitute* another ball, without penalty, and take relief as prescribed in Rule 24-2b(ii).

In other words, a ball, known for sure, to be lost in a bunker, the player may substitute another ball, without penalty, and take a free drop in the bunker.
