I need to ask for your help, concerning your score keeping during your rounds. Basically too many of the scorecards are not completed when handed in at the end of play. For example, the final tallies are not done, (gross score minus handicap equals net score, etc) you need to hand in a scorecard that's correct, signed and legible. One player was almost disqualified because the handwriting was so sloppy that many of the scores were hard to interpret. So please record your scores, do all the math, sign the card and try to be neat. You're breaking a rule of golf by not completing an accurate scorecard, so remember to take this part of the game seriously. Even if you're having a bad day and you know you won't be in contention, you still must hand in an accurate scorecard. It's part of the rules of golf. If we continue to have this problem and cards are incomplete, we will be forced not to record a score for you, thus your score won't be used in computing your newest handicap. Thank you for your cooperation.

Our annual end of year awards banquet is just around the corner (June 26th) at Stoneybrook East. Besides the awards we'll be handing out, we're also collecting many great door prizes. We'll easily have over 60 different prizes so your chances of winning are great. Our grand prize will be a weekend golf outing at Juliette Falls for 4 people. You'll be staying at a beautifully furnished pool home, flat TV's in all rooms, granite top kitchen, etc. We have many other nice prizes, with good food, etc. So we hope to see you all there.
