We also had some good scoring. Our low gross winner was Al Chandler who shot a 78. Ken Copley was our low net winner, shooting an 85 net 62. Both of you played very well. Congratulations! Then we had the winners of each flight, A - Gary Miller, B - George Frey (he had lowest # of putts) and C - Jeff Danjou. It's good to see new names at the top of each flight. Nice job.

All you members that normally don't play either the net or gross skin games should think about playing in one. There were 5 winners at Green Valley in the gross skins game, each skin paid \$52. In the net skins game there were 8 skins, each paid \$24 ea. Both games are easy to play, just review the games details from the Agogolf.net web site. I think when you're in one of the games you tend to concentrate more and shoot a better score. Competition can bring out the best in most people.

I want to take the time to thank one of our board members for all his efforts and the time he's volunteered toward AGO. Gerry Bruessel is stepping down from the board and we will miss him. Gerry is busy with his "Harley" club and will become more involved with helping run that organization. Gerry said he'd still play at many AGO events but had too many irons in the fire.

Since we have many new members, we're taking an article that Rich Harris wrote for this newsletter years ago. It's worth reading again.

### **TITLE: WHAT TO DO**

#### **A Review of Instructions for NEW and OLD AGO Members**

These instructions are being provided to (A) New AGO members (B) Old AGO members and (C) Potential AGO members by YOUR AGO Board of Directors for 2010-11. It's as simple as A-B-C above and counting to six!

- 1. If, and when, you hear about the Amateur Golfers of Orlando (AGO) you should CALL the AGO Hotline ( 407-273-7798) or Larry Prill (407-718-2907) or Rick Harris (407-282-4883) or the AGO Web site ([www.agogolf.net](http://www.agogolf.net)) about becoming a member and how to sign up for the next event. Generally we play the third Sunday of every month somewhere in the Orlando area. We ALWAYS play in the morning at 8:00 A.M. or 8:30 a.m. depending upon the distance from downtown Orlando.**
- 2. If you decide to play SEND IN YOUR ENTRY FEE to the AGO PO Box 140181, Orlando Florida, 32814 with your check made out to AGO for the designated amount. You should send your entry blank and check about seven days prior to the Wednesday BEFORE the tournament date. The WEDNESDAY before the Sunday tournament is the deadline for your guarantee that you will play. Any entries received after that puts you in a TENTATIVE status where you need to check by phone, e-mail, etc. to see if you are playing.**
- 3. On tournament day your FIRST duty is to find the tournament check-in table where you will be given a hole assignment, scorecard, and an opportunity to enroll in several contests that include, net skins, gross skins and the par 3 game. You will be automatically enrolled in a 50-50 drawing to win cash. That one ticket will be attached to your scorecard. You can also buy additional tickets to help improve your chances.**
- 4. After getting your hole assignment you should locate your golf cart and make sure your golf clubs, shoes, etc. are on the correct cart, the hole you're starting on should be on the cart and your scorecard. In most cases the courses have attendants who have a master list and will get your clubs on the proper cart. After that you may practice putting, go to the driving range, meet new or old friends, etc. Approximately 15 minutes prior to tee-off all players will be asked to go to the golf carts to LISTEN to last minute instructions from the pro and your AGO board. Our GOAL is to complete the round BEFORE a FIVE HOUR and FIVE MINUTE deadline. Should you take longer than that you may be DISQUALIFIED delaying the tournament. The rangers at all of the golf courses have the authority to request that your foursome increase its pace, and report to the AGO board those players that have been warned two times or more. The general rule is to keep up visually with the foursome in front of you by playing READY GOLF!**
- 5. At the conclusion of play a foursome should pull off to a safe place away from the last hole and make sure YOUR scorecard totals are correct by adding your GROSS score, subtracting your handicap, and determining your NET score. If you enrolled in a gross or net score contest you should keep a SEPARATE card. Please add up you total putts**

as well. **MAKE SURE YOUR SCORECARD HAS TWO SIGNATURES. I.E. THE PERSON WHO KEPT YOUR SCORE, AND YOUR SIGNATURE. NOTE, failure to sign your card or have a witness to your signature MAY lead to disqualification. If there are any discrepancies settle them before you leave the course or bring them to the attention of an AGO board member.**

6. Last but not least **BE SURE AND TURN IN YOUR SCORECARD** before doing anything else. Your AGO board members need to verify that ALL cards are in and wrap up the tournament as quickly and efficiently as possible. The golf pro may have another shotgun or a large group of people waiting for the golf carts and we need to pay him for the tournament when it has finished. After that you may return your clubs to your car, get a bite to eat, visit with friends, etc. but **TURN IN YOUR COMPLETED SCORECARD !**

**#note: The first four people who notify Larry Prill, AGO president, and say "A-B-C and easy as counting to six" on Sunday, Feb. 20<sup>th</sup> at Arlington Ridge will receive one sleeve of golf balls free as proof that you read this article.**

## Rule of the Month

### Loose Impediments

**"Loose impediments" are natural objects including:**

**stones, leaves, twigs, branches and the like, dung, and worms, insects and the like, and the casts and heaps made by them, provided they are not: fixed or growing, solidly embedded, or adhering to the ball. Sand and loose soil are loose impediments on the *putting green*, but not elsewhere. Snow and natural ice, other than frost, are either *casual water* or loose impediments, at the option of the player. Dew and frost are not loose impediments.**

**Rule 23-1: When a ball is in motion, a loose impediment that might influence the movement of the ball must not be removed. Penalty for Breach of Rule: Match play - Loss of hole; Stroke play - Two strokes.**
