#### Rule of the Month- Equipment and Balls

##### 4-2. Playing Characteristics Changed and Foreign Material

###### a. Playing Characteristics Changed

During a stipulated round, the playing characteristics of a club must not be purposely changed by adjustment or by any other means. (This includes changing putter/driver weights, lead tape, vaseline or spray on clubface, etc).

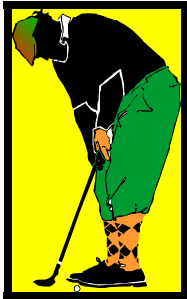
###### b. Foreign Material

Foreign material must not be applied to the clubface for the purpose of influencing the movement of the ball.

PENALTY FOR CARRYING, BUT NOT MAKING STROKE WITH, CLUB OR CLUBS IN BREACH OF RULE 4-1 or 4-2: Stroke play - Two strokes for each hole at which any breach occurred; maximum penalty per round - Four strokes.

**Playing the Ball Rule 15-1. General** If a player substitutes a ball when not permitted to do so under the Rules, that substituted ball is not a wrong ball; it becomes the ball in play. If the mistake is not corrected as provided in Rule 20-6 and the player makes a stroke at a wrongly substituted ball, he loses the hole in match play or incurs a penalty of two strokes in stroke play under the applicable Rule and, in stroke play, must play out the hole with the substituted ball. If a player substitutes a ball when not permitted to do so under the Rules, that substituted ball is not a wrong ball; it becomes the ball in play. If the mistake is not corrected as provided in Rule 20-6 and the player makes a stroke at a wrongly substituted ball, he loses the hole in match play or incurs a penalty of two strokes in stroke play under the applicable Rule and, in stroke play, must play out the hole with the substituted ball.

**USGA Rules of Golf apply during all AGO events.** Many of the rules get quite involved. If you have questions about a rule covered in the newsletter, just go to the USGA website, and go to the online Rules of Golf, browsing the rule menu until you find the category for your question, then point and click.

**Reminder:** New members must play in **3 rounds** to establish their AGO handicap to compete for net prizes. All new members are eligible to win closest to pin, gross skins, 50/50 raffle and blind bogey after providing a #.

Turn right onto 17/92 and go three miles and you will come to the Providence community on the left hand side. Go thru the guardhouse and follow the road straight (go through the round about) back and you will see the clubhouse on the left.

### Directions to: Orange Lake Legends

Take Interstate 4 West (toward Tampa) Continue on Interstate 4 to U.S. Hwy 192 (18 miles from Downtown, 7 miles from International Drive) Take U.S. Hwy 192 West (exit 64\*), towards Disney World Merge onto U.S. Hwy 192 West and then merge to the two left-hand lanes. Continue U.S. Hwy 192 West for approx 5 miles to the East Orange Lake Boulevard. Turn Right into E. Orange Lake Blvd, follow all the way, through rotary, then going east toward Legends Clubhouse and Legends Dr. NOTE: Most mapping takes you farther West to Orange Lake Blvd, to enter property. It is not known if guard house or gate exists on E. Orange Lake Blvd., but it is shorter and more direct to clubhouse.
