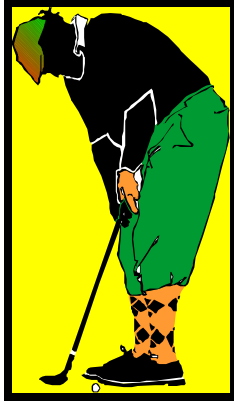

We try to place the lower handicapped players in front followed by "B & C" flight players, etc. We use the triple bogey rule when we feel the course warrants it. I am also asking the courses have player assistants patrol our field and to be more aggressive with slower groups. You all can help by keeping up with the group in front of you and play ready golf. Be more concerned with keeping pace with the people in front of you. Don't worry about the group behind you; it's the group that's ahead of you that matters. If you're keeping up with them (there always in your sight) then that's all you can do. Remember, playing to slow is against the rules and you can be disqualified for finishing to late. Plus this time of the year it's too hot to be spending more than 4 ½ hours cooking in such heat.

We have some great courses lined up for the rest of the year and I encourage all members to take advantage and come out and support your AGO tournaments. Don't let the cost of gas stop you from driving to any of our events. Start thinking about car-pooling. I see some of our members doing this and that's great. If you want to car pool start talking to others about taking

turns in driving. Many of you live closer than you think to other members, find some players you can take turns in the driving and come out and play.

Looking forward to playing Harbor Hills again. Yes, it's up there but I feel it's worth the extra driving time. Hope you all can make it; it's a pretty course with wide-open fairways.

Rule 26. Water Hazards (Including Lateral Water Hazards)

Definitions

All defined terms are in *italics* and are listed alphabetically in the Definitions section.

26-1. Relief for Ball in Water Hazard

It is a question of fact whether a ball that has not been found after having been struck toward a [water hazard](#) is in the [hazard](#). In order to apply this Rule, it must be known or virtually certain that the ball is in the [hazard](#). In the absence of such knowledge or certainty, the player must proceed under Rule [27-1](#).

If a ball is in a [water hazard](#) or if it is known or virtually certain that a ball that has not been found is in a [water hazard](#) (whether the ball lies in water or not), the player may **under penalty of one stroke**:

- Play a ball as nearly as possible at the spot from which the original ball was last played (see Rule [20-5](#)); or
- Drop a ball behind the [water hazard](#), keeping the point at which the original ball last crossed the margin of the [water hazard](#) directly between the [hole](#) and the spot on which the ball is dropped, with no limit to how far behind the [water hazard](#) the ball may be dropped; or
- As additional options available only if the ball last crossed the margin of a [lateral water hazard](#), drop a ball outside the [water hazard](#) within two club-lengths of and not nearer the [hole](#) than (i) the point where the original ball last crossed the margin of the [water hazard](#) or (ii) a point on the opposite margin of the [water hazard](#) equidistant from the [hole](#).

When proceeding under this Rule, the player may lift and clean his ball or [substitute](#) a ball.

(Prohibited actions when ball is in hazard - see Rule [13-4](#).)

(Ball moving in water in a water hazard - see Rule [14-6](#).)
