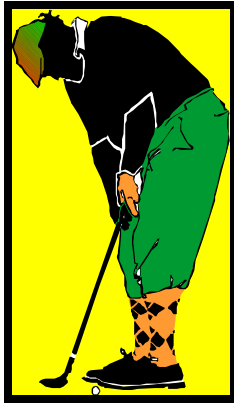

FROM THE PRESIDENT'S DESK

Providence turned out to be a great day of golf. Even a little bit of rain didn't stop any AGO golfers from having a good time. The staff was very cooperative and it was a pleasure to work with them. I'm sure we'll be going back in the near future.

We introduced a new game at Providence, our 50/50 raffle. As you know you were all automatically entered for one \$1.00 ticket. Plus you had the opportunity to buy more tickets to help increase your chances of winning. Balbino Farino was our first winner, his number was drawn and he won a cool \$83.00. At our next tournament this month we'll continue the 50/50 and you'll still be able to purchase tickets prior to the drawing - \$1.00 gets one ticket, \$2.00 gets 3 tickets and \$5.00 gets 10 tickets. What a deal.

I frequently stress the importance of growing our AGO membership. All members are the best source for inviting potential new golfers. New members need to know they don't have to bring an established handicap when joining. We used to accept most handicaps that a new member gave us. Even though many were legitimate, some weren't and we all got burned. So we established the rule that a new member must play at three AGO events in order to establish a handicap. This rule helps protect us all. It's our job to

protect the field in order for AGO to continue to run fair golf tournaments.

A new member does not pay the full entry fee during this time and can't participate in some of the handicap based games. But he can still participate in our 50/50, blind bogey, hole in one pot, closest to the pin, low putts, plus he can enter the gross skins and the par 3 game. Every player enjoys good value for their money when they play in an AGO tournament. The average cost per event is under \$50. Possibly, some may not like this rule because they thought the handicaps they brought with them would be accepted. But once they've completed their three rounds, then they'll appreciate that they're playing in tournaments against golfers who are using handicaps based on golfing only at AGO events.

So, when talking to potential new members use this as a selling point, they can join an organization that is a fair league (no sandbaggers) and still be able to win prizes and cash. You get a lot for your money; so spread the word.

Teeing Ground

The "teeing ground" is the starting place for the hole to be played. It is a rectangular area two club-lengths in depth, the front and the sides of which are defined by the outside limits of two tee-markers. A ball is outside the teeing ground when all of it lies outside the teeing ground.

Stroke Play

If a *competitor*, when starting a hole, plays a ball from outside the *teeing ground*, he incurs a penalty of two strokes and must then play a ball from within the *teeing ground*.

If the *competitor* makes a *stroke* from the next *teeing ground* without first correcting his mistake or, in the case of the last hole of the round, leaves the *putting green* without first declaring his intention to correct his mistake, he is disqualified.

The *stroke* from outside the *teeing ground* and any subsequent *strokes* by the *competitor* on the hole prior to his correction of the mistake do not count in his score.
