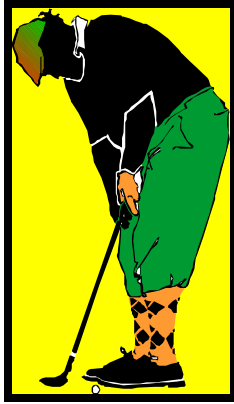

## **FROM THE PRESIDENT'S DESK**

O.K. Here is the situation! We have good news and bad news!

At the present time we have 120 AGO members who have renewed for the 2005-06 season! We closed out this past year with approximately 190 members. During the past 12 months we've lost, through attrition, factors of bad health or moving to another city, about 20 members, including SIX members of our AGO board, like John Coen, Doc Hebebrand for health reasons, three members who resigned from the board after their "tour of duty" and one, George Rackensperger, a transfer to, of all places, GEORGIA! Other names that come to mind of moving to other states are Don Gage, Winston Harris and Jerry Geier, along with at least 10 others who left for a variety of personal reasons.

On the other side of the ledger we have gone through this "stale period" before when the pressures of a dislike for some course(s), vacation, transfer from one job to another, loss of job of family member, or personal reasons have interfered with the thought process of sending in their renewal dues and signing up for the next tournament. We HAVE signed up new members who have just heard about us, and a few have returned to AGO after a dry period of several years. So it will be interesting to see what happens in the next 90 days as we move our tournaments to Diamond Players Club in Clermont, Kissimmee Oaks and Solivita during the autumn months as the days get cooler.

In the future I will report to you about our increase in membership; how our 5 hour and 5 minute time limit (average 17 minutes PER HOLE) and triple bogey maximum is going, and any other information that you need to know. Every one in awhile I will refresh your memory about the fundamentals of AGO like playing ready golf. In the meantime enjoy your summer vacations and consider bring a guest or two along (at reduced rates) to see if they would like to belong to AGO.

## **GUESTS!**

In the past we have charged the tournament rate for any guests that our members bring to play with AGO. After consideration by the AGO Board, it was felt since a guest doesn't participate in prizes, they shouldn't be charged the prize package. As a result, a guest will only be charged the tournament rate, **less the prize package** (which is usually \$8) to play. For example: At Diamond Player's Club the tournament rate is \$39. The prize package is \$8. A guest will be charge only \$31. For obvious reasons, a player can only play as a guest one time!
