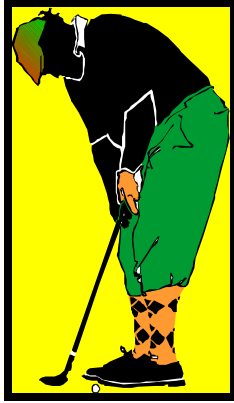

FROM THE PRESIDENT'S DESK

SHORT AND SWEET

- If you have not renewed your annual dues by now, you WILL NOT be allowed to play with AGO until you have. Considering the GREAT places that we will be playing (see schedule) during the next 4-5 months and the possible formats we will use, you'll be missing out if you are not a member.
- AGO's policy on arriving LATE for an event:: We had an unfortunate situation this past month at Arlington Ridge when a few players arrived at the golf course after everyone had teed off. Since we follow USGA rules (see 6.3 re: time of starting groups) basically, if everyone tees off at a specific time but a player is ready for play WITHIN FIVE MINUTES after that, a penalty of two strokes may be assessed by the committee and the player may then complete play as part of the tournament. AFTER five minutes the committee can, and will, rule that the player is disqualified from the competition. HOWEVER, since the player paid for the round, they may play but will NOT be eligible for ANY prizes.

FURTHER, since it takes several minutes for all groups to get to a tee it would be logical that another five minutes or so will still enable the player to get to a tee in time to join his group and tee off with them WITHOUT penalty. NOTE: If you arrive at your proper tee and all of the other players have teed off, you will be considered late and will be assessed a two stroke penalty, but are still eligible to play and compete for prizes. AS A GENERAL RULE, if the player arrives at the proper tee and his group has COMPLETED the first hole of the day, the late player is disqualified, but may still play the round, but will NOT be eligible for prizes. ANOTHER NOTE: If possible please call the golf course and let them know that you are still coming to play so that logistically we can save your spot within your group, and perhaps you can make it in time to just receive a two stroke penalty and not be DQ'd.

- MATCH PLAY: In the past we used to have a Match Play Championship series

which was played separately from the AGO monthly event, during a six week or so period. If you would like to have a MATCH PLAY series please contact Rick Harris in person or at 407-282-4883 to sign up. Some general rules are: We MUST have a minimum of 28 players which will be divided into TWO flights with a couple of byes in each flight. Entry fee is \$6.00 per player for the entire tournament. Harris will make up pairings and assign opponents who will contact each other to play golf at a mutually agreed upon site. Opponents must play each other within a ten day to two week period. LET ME KNOW IF YOU ARE INTERESTED. If so we will begin match play in September.

Proceed on the 408-Expressway east until you merge with 417 north toward Sanford. Follow 417 north to exit 41 (Red Bug Lake Road exit). Proceed down the ramp and take a right (east) and follow Red Bug Road approximately 3 ½ miles to Lockwood Blvd. Take a right on Lockwood Blvd. and follow for 1 mile and the club is on your left. Please note Red Bug Rd turns into Mitchell Hammock shortly after you exit 417, please stay straight on Mitchell Hammock until it dead ends into Lockwood
