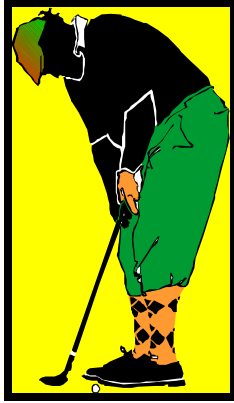

## FROM THE PRESIDENT'S DESK

**Thank you to all for attending AGO golf at the Sanctuary in November. We had a pretty good turnout and a lot of high scores. Looking for balls, hitting balls out of bounds and climbing up and down hills created slow play. Most finished in time but some players are slow. We have over looked players going past the 5 hour 5 minute DQ rule by a few minutes but we just can't have a few players coming in almost an hour late. We see who continually comes in late and we will inform them about this problem.**

**I want to remind everyone to get your entries in for December. Due to Christmas, we're playing one week earlier than usual. Dec. 14<sup>th</sup> at Orange Lake Resort – The Reserve Course. In the future, remember you don't have to wait for the entry form in the newsletter to register for a tournament. Rule-sheets are distributed at every tournament, one to each cart. At the bottom there's an entry form for registering for upcoming events. You can also go to the website and get an entry form off any newsletter that's posted. So don't wait until the last minute, enter as soon as you can.**

**We're also beginning to look ahead at next year. For you new members we have always played our championships on two different courses (Saturday & Sunday) the third weekend of April, then in the following month we'd have our end of the year awards banquet to recognize these winners. It has been a challenge to secure good courses at a fair rate because its still in season and the costs are still high. May gets better but we still have to pay for the golf, prize money and the banquet. With this in mind the board is discussing moving our two-day championships to June, July or August and the banquet to July, August or September. All the courses are begging for groups in the summer, so we could get better courses at a lower rate. Thus the two-month outlay could be reduced, and we play better courses. ### 15-3. Wrong Ball

#### ■ ■ b. Stroke Play

If a [competitor](#) makes a [stroke](#) or [strokes](#) at a [wrong ball](#), he incurs a penalty of two strokes.

The [competitor](#) must correct his mistake by playing the correct ball or by proceeding under the [Rules](#). If he fails to correct his mistake before making a [stroke](#) on the next [teeing ground](#) or, in the case of the last hole of the round, fails to declare his intention to correct his mistake before leaving the [putting green](#), he is disqualified.

[strokes](#) made by a [competitor](#) with a [wrong ball](#) do not count in his score. If the [wrong ball](#) belongs to another [competitor](#), its owner must place a ball on the spot from which the [wrong ball](#) was first played.

**Exception:** There is no penalty if a [competitor](#) makes a [stroke](#) at a [wrong ball](#) that is moving in water in a [water hazard](#). Any [strokes](#) made at a [wrong ball](#) moving in water in a [water hazard](#) do not count in the [competitor's](#) score.

(Lie of ball to be placed or replaced altered - see Rule [20-3b](#).)

(Spot not determinable - see Rule [20-3c](#).)
